 - b. Understanding of the mission, vision, and goals of NJAEYC.

 - d. Knowledge of issues facing the field and have the ability to conceptualize the appropriate role for the Association.
 - e. Awareness of the Association's priority to be a highly functioning organization that is continually enriched by its institutional commitment to diversity and inclusion.
 - f. Strong interpersonal skills with an ability to objectively consider various perspectives to guide major policy decisions of the Association;
